Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy

<u>Jane Saunders and Manning Ltd</u> are committed to acting in a responsible and ethical manner. We have a zero tolerance approach to slavery and human trafficking ("modern slavery.")

Modern slavery is a crime and a violation of fundamental human rights. It takes various forms, such as slavery, servitude, forced and compulsory labour and human trafficking, all of which have in common the deprivation of a person's liberty by another in order to exploit them for personal or commercial gain.

<u>Jane Saunders and Manning Ltd</u> prohibits the practice of modern slavery in all company operations and within our global supply chains. We have adopted a slavery assessment tool, which enables us to take a risk based approach to mitigate modern slavery within our operations and supply chains. Through this assessment and the results from self —assessment questionnaires, further auditing may be identified as necessary.

<u>Jane Saunders and Manning Ltd</u> prohibition on modern slavery applies to all persons working for the Group or on its behalf in any capacity, and will investigate any claim or indication that a supplier is engaging, directly or indirectly, in human trafficking or slavery. If a supplier is found in violation of this policy, <u>Jane Saunders and Manning Ltd</u> will take remedial measures to address the violation.

Certain companies are exempt from making a statement on Modern Slavery as they do not fit the criteria defined by HM Government on compliance. However, this does not absolve our suppliers from satisfying <u>Jane Saunders and Manning Ltd</u> requirements to be certain our suppliers are not engaging in modern slavery or their supply chains. Therefore, we request a definitive statement from any company that there is no evidence of modern slavery within, or associated with any organisation.
